Report on Health & Disability Mapping

- Dawn introduced the work that the Trust is doing in Kirklees and 3 other areas (Barnsley, Calderdale and Wakefield) around mental health, community, learning disabilities, and wellbeing - <https://www.southwestyorkshire.nhs.uk/>.
- They want to know more about what the third sector is doing in Kirklees and form stronger relationships. They recognise the value of what the sector does but don't know specifically who is doing what & so they commissioned TSL Kirklees to talk to local organisations, put them in touch with the key people and help them understand the sort of services and activities that we provide.
- Mithu Komarnyckyj was contracted by TSL Kirklees to do a survey, which included some extra questions about their knowledge of and relationship with TSL Kirklees, and we included groups working with people with physical disabilities too.
- Following on from this work we want to develop a 'disability network' that responds to the needs of the groups in it, offers 'sounding boards' for people to raise issues and ask questions, and aims to strengthen relationships with health partners. It will also include a small grants scheme that allows groups to demonstrate the value of their community-based activity & how it meets SWYPFT's priorities. This will be launched in September.
- In addition to this, the SWYFT video project is about TSL identifying 5 organisations from specific groups to make a short video for SWYFT staff training purposes about any specific needs - cultural/physical/emotional - the people they work with have in relation to how they'd want to be treated by SWYFT staff. They would like to feature groups that work with Afro Caribbean, Muslim, Sikh, learning disabilities and young carer groups in the community.

- Each group will be paid £500 for their time. Filming and editing will be done by a professional video production company.
